The Department of Children and Families will provide financial assistance for any child adopted from DCF foster care after December 31, 2004 toward the cost of any post-high school degree or accredited program that the adopted child is accepted into, provided the child attends full time. The waiver can be up to the annual cost of the University of Connecticut, including tuition, fees, and room and board.
